Child Find Campaign

The Amite County School District participates with the Mississippi Department of Education in an ongoing, statewide effort to identify, locate, and evaluate children through age twenty-one who have health impairments, physical, mental, communicative, and/or emotional disabilities.

Each year, the Office of Special Services serves approximately 250 students with disabilities in thirteen categories as identified by the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA 2004). A full continuum of services is offered to students with disabilities, who are eligible under IDEA. Highly qualified teachers, therapists, and trained support personnel strive to offer the most appropriate programming options for each student based on his/her individual needs.
